



FIND YOUR PATH TO ACTION

Step 1: What's your appetite for action?

What's your level of comfort and readiness for action?

- **Easy:** Quick actions that fit into everyday life
- **Free:** Actions that cost nothing but still make a difference
- **Impactful:** Actions that take more effort and create deeper change
- **Political:** Actions that engage with decision-makers and systems

Step 2: What change do you want to work towards?

How do you want to make a difference?

Do some good: Help in the short term

Spread the word: Raise awareness

Change the system: Tackle root causes

Step 3: Putting it all together
